

CONFLICT MINERALS POLICY

As Trakya Döküm, we carry out our activities with the aim of minimizing their negative impacts on the environment, society and economy. Apart from our activities, we also evaluate and monitor the indirect impacts that may arise in the supply chain. Procurement of tantalum, tin, tungsten and gold (3TG) minerals, which are used in the production of many products in the responsible supply chain, is important for our industry.

In line with our Conflict Minerals Policy, as Trakya Döküm, we adopt the following principles:

- Working with suppliers who purchase and use minerals and raw materials produced in conflict-free regions,
- Collaborating with our suppliers to identify the smelters of minerals, the country of origin of the mined minerals, and the location where the minerals are sourced, in order to determine the presence of conflict minerals in the value chain,
- Identifying our suppliers with potential risks of sourcing minerals from conflict-affected and high-risk regions, collaborating with them to mitigate risks, and stopping cooperation with suppliers who cannot minimize risks,
- Collaborating with our suppliers, third parties such as national/international institutions and civil society organizations to prevent or minimize the adverse impacts of conflict minerals,
- Resisting attempts to offer bribes to conceal or change the origin of conflict minerals,
- Supporting efforts to effectively eliminate money laundering in the trade of conflict minerals and taking appropriate actions in accordance with legislation.
